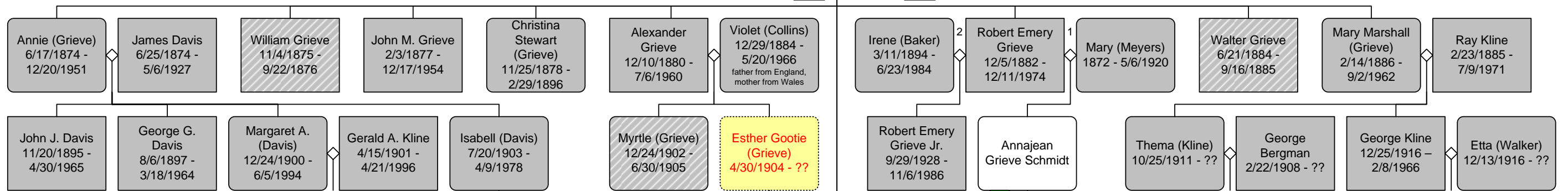
14 Children!, though 2 died young. Married: 11/7/1873 in Wilksburg, PA Coal Miner, then Hotelkeepers GG is from Scotland Immigrated 1871?

Immigrated Scotland to US 5/10/1849 to Philadelphia aboard the ship Thomas H. Perkins, accompanied by David McIntyre (age 45). David might have been his father. Alleghany City census of 1850? lists a John McIntyre. (info from a Grieve reunion mailing researched by Norman & Joan McIntyre)

Died Gateside, Barrhead 6/20/1877 (age 93)

Both from Scotland John from Eastwood Parish, Anne from Barrhead, near Glasgow. Mary Walker McIntyre was born to John & Anne after they came to the US.

Thelma & George & their spouses are new data from Wolf-Haines. Add to BK db. No children listed. ARE ANY LIVING?

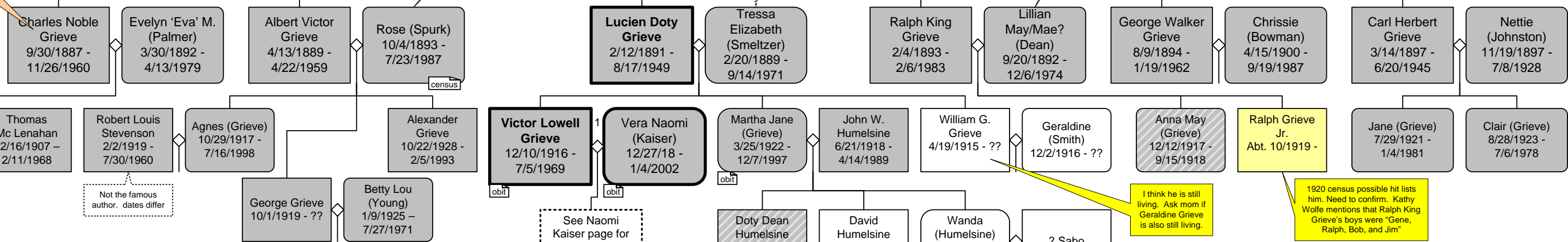
look at 1920 census hit, more details for this subfamily. Father-in-law mentioned
